Pay attention to our display case in the lobby where volunteers create subjects of interest about Chatsworth.


We have a great group of volunteers who join us at the book sales to sort books, sell and just have fun.

Library Book Club



A battered child learns to embrace life when he is taken in by a reclusive old man in the English countryside during WW II.




June 3, 2015 <u>Orphan Train</u> by Christina Baker Kline – Fiction – 2013 – 278 pages.


