"Sidewalk Astronomers are not just people with telescopes....The real experience of astronomy begins when a person's mind is re-opened to the possibility of the Universe. Seeing a small crowd standing around a telescope is often enough to begin that re-awakening. People standing in line at the eyepiece will naturally look up to notice a star or planet that was there all the time, had they only thought to look. We hope he will look again the next night, and the next."


