
Wednesday, July 09, 2014 3:00pm to 4:00pm Sunshine Drum Circle Stories with Ina and Chazz

August 6, 2014 Mr. Churchill's Secretary by

Susan MacNeal – Mystery - 2012 - 323 pages. In 1940's London, Maggie Hope, a bright young woman trained in math and code breaking, tries to unravel an assination plot while working as Winston Churchill's secretary.

September 3, 2014 <u>*Cutting for Stone*</u> by Abraham Verghese – Fiction – 2009 -541 pages

Twin boys are orphaned in Ethiopia when their Indian mother dies and their British surgeon father abandons them. Their passion for the same woman tears them apart and causes Marion to flee his homeland and go to America to work as an intern in a New York City hospital.

October 1, 2014 <u>Odyssev</u> by Homer – Call # 883 H72An – 309 pages

An ancient Greek epic poem which tells of the travels of Odysseus following the fall of Troy. The story follows his efforts to return to his faithful wife, Penelope, and his kingdom in Ithaca. This is a "Big Read" selection.
