The library Book Club discussion group meets every first Wednesday of the month from 1 - 2:30 PM. in the Library Meeting Room. Our schedule of reading for the next few months is as follows:

#### July 5<sup>th</sup> - "Year of Wonders" by Gerealdine Brooks

A vividly imagined novel of the plague, a strangely consoling tale of hope in at time of despair.

#### August 2 - "The Bookseller of Kabul" by Asne Seierstad

An intimate and brutally honest portrayal of the life of a family living in Afghanistan in 2001.

September 6<sup>th</sup> – "All the Pain that Money Can Buy" by William Wright. The life of Christina Onassis.

#### October 4th - "Emma," Jane Austen

Austen, one of the earliest English novelists, writes humorously of a young aristocratic woman whose most urgent preoccupation is courtship and marriage.

Books for future reading are chosen in discussion at the meetings and ordered in multiple copies from other libraries for the use of book club members. They are available at the Circulation Desk, upon request, approximately two to three weeks before each meeting. Everyone is welcome to attend.
