

FROM THE FRIENDS PRESIDENT:



Welcome back everyone from a hot summer vacation. School is now back in session and everyone has their nose to the grindstone.

I would like to thank our board members Ann and Ray Vincent for spending much of their summer negotiating with the L.A. Library officials, in persuading them to give their OK to the installation of storage cabinets in the community room at the Chatsworth Branch Library. Ann and Ray did this by writing up plans and proposals which the Library people eventually accepted. I was with them throughout the process and was impressed with their first class efforts, as I am sure, were the people at the Central Library.

The FOL are funding the cabinets but are hoping that we can find alternative funding elsewhere. The cabinets will be used by the FOL as storage for used books and will ensure that the book sales will continue in the future as a source of revenue for the Chatsworth Branch Library. Storage of the used books has been a problem for the FOL. for years; these cabinets will solve that and make book sales so much easier to setup and tear-down. They won't be ready for our October sale, but should be installed by January.
